Teams – Riders over 16yrs*

Fences will not generally exceed 100cm. Time – Optimum

Teams – Riders over 16yrs*

Fences will not generally exceed 115cm. Time – Optimum Entry fee: £140 Prizes: 1st £130, 2nd £120, 3rd £110

ON ARRIVAL

Please report to the secretary's tent based by the double decker buses to collect your numbers as we are using number bibs this year (you will not be required to print your own numbers - you will need a £50 deposit), confirm arrival and amend any names for commentary. Please be aware the course crosses the road so please adhere to our stewards requests.

HATS AND BODY PROTECTORS

Hats will be identified by a BTC, BE, BRC, or Pony Club approved Hat Tag. I.e. Hats must meet one of the following standards: British All PAS015 1998/2011 with kitemark; VG1 with kitemark; All ASTM F1163: 2004 onwards with SEI mark; SNELL E2001 or E2016 with Snell label and number, or Australian and New Zealand All AS/NZS 3838 2006-onwards hats. All competitors must also wear a British Equestrian Trade Association (BETA 2009) approved and appropriately labelled Level 3 (purple label) body protector, manufactured in the year 2009 or after. A body protector of this nature is also required when competitors are wearing air jackets of any make.

EQUINE VACCINATIONS

All horses attending this event should be vaccinated against equine influenza. We will only accept horses that have had a booster within the last 12 months. Spot checks will be carried out by veterinary surgeons.

WALKING THE COURSE

The course can be walked from Saturday 24th September between 2pm and 5pm. Please try not to touch or climb on the fences. The course will be open from 7.30am Sunday morning for walking. We will be utilising Sector Stewards so there may not be a fence judge at every fence. Therefore, please listen for horses on the course, whistles and use your common sense when walking close to the fences. You are walking the course at your own risk.

PRIZE GIVING

There will be a prize giving this year. Outside the secretary's tent in the main start and finish field. Prizes will be announced over the loudspeakers but be prepared to come to the bus within 30 mins of the last horse. All prize money will be sent via BACS to the winning teams. OBJECTIONS AND SCORING QUERIES

WARM UP AND COMPETING

This year we will have a non-jumping warm up ring and then the jumping collecting ring. The collecting ring will only be open to competitors 15 minutes before their allotted time. A steward will be managing this. Number bibs must always be worn in the collecting ring.

You are expected to ride on your allocated times. If you do not do so, you risk being unable to compete.

Dogs are allowed on leads only... £50 fine for any dog not on a lead.

EMERGENCY SERVICES

Veterinary Surgeons, Full Medical Team, Farrier and Horse Ambulance will be onsite during the competition. Competitors will be required to pay for any equine services
